SERIOUS SCIENCE FAIR INFORMATION:

* The above written requirements comprise the science fair paper and will be written at school. **Each student is responsible to complete the remainder of the project at home – backboard, experimentation, collection of data, and journal.**

* **A complete science fair project includes a paper, a backboard, an experiment that was tested ten times and data was collected, and a journal.**

* The **highlighted assignments** above will be collected and returned for corrections. Two copies of each requirements must be printed. One copy goes on the backboard and one copy is placed in the paper.

* The non-highlighted assignments **will NOT be brought to school** until the day of the science fair which is **Monday – January 28, 2019.**

* Everyone in grade 8 is required to have an experimental project. **There are NO EXCEPTIONS!** If a student is absent the day of the science fair, all requirements must still be brought to school as the science fair only takes place on Monday -January 28, 2019.
